Interprovincial Criteria Munster Region 2026

1. There will be **NINE** legs in Munster plus the final.
2. Minimum of three appearances to jump in Munster final, Pony/Athlete combination. Must have three appearances in the height band you want to jump in at the final. (you can jump in multiple heights and classes but must have three appearances)
3. **For Pony/Athlete combinations in the following Heights ONLY 128 1mt/138 110/148 120 - Two appearance will be accepted if competing in RDS Qualifiers 2026. (will be monitored)**
4. League Points will be awarded at the Munster Final to Pony/Athlete combinations.
5. Pony/Athlete combinations that are in **CONTENTION** for Leading Rider and interested in going to the all-Ireland National Finals they **MUST** compete at the Munster Finals.
6. You may compete for qualifying place at any venue that is hosting a qualifier in the Munster Region
7. Top 5 on day of final will automatically qualify for a place on an Interprovincial team in each class.
8. Top five on leaderboard will automatically qualify for a place on an Interprovincial team in each class but must compete at the Munster Final.
9. In the event of the quota of ten riders per class not being filled for the National finals, preference will be given to competitors who jumped in Munster finals. If there are still places to fill the Regional Pony rep will use the Wild Card Option.
10. A rider may compete three ponies at the Munster finals but may only take one position on the team for national finals. If the ten combinations are not filled, then they may ride their second pony at the National finals.
11. All qualifiers are league qualifiers.
12. Cash prizes will be paid to each class at the Munster final which will be held in Tipperary Equestrian Centre. Rugs and sashes for all winners in each class and all leading riders
13. Cash prizes (or by bank transfer) will also be paid to each class at the National finals. Rugs and sashes for all winners in each class and all leading riders
14. In the event of a tie in placings team selection points will go to the highest placed rider in the Class.
15. This league is open to all Pony/Athlete combination in 128, 138, 148 & COH - starting with 50cm Class
16. League tables will be published on each branch's and SJI's Facebook page.
17. **Leading Rider will be based on the NINE Qualifying Rounds, unless on equal points going into the final – BUT to get your TITLE you must compete at the Munster Final.**
18. The organizing committee reserves the right to make changes should it be deemed necessary.
