

## Leinster Amateur Tour 2025 (LAT 2025)

The Leinster amateur committee are delighted to announce the return of the "Leinster Amateur Tour 2025" which will consist of a series of legs throughout the Leinster region during the coming months, culminating with the grand final on the weekend of the September 6<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup> of September where the overall "Leinster Amateur Tour 2025" Champion will be crowned!

**Final: Mullingar Equestrian Centre 6<sup>th</sup>/7<sup>th</sup> of September**

### Rules and eligibility for the final:

- Each leg of the tour has to be run as a standalone amateur class
- Any competitor who has competed at 2 rounds of the tour is eligible to compete at the final.
- Riders from all regions are eligible to compete
- Tour points will be awarded as follows at all legs of the tour, including the final and the league table points will be based on horse/rider combination  
1<sup>st</sup> = 10, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 8, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 7, 4<sup>th</sup> = 6, 5<sup>th</sup> = 5, 6<sup>th</sup> = 4  
Appearance at a leg of the tour = 2 points
- If there is a tie for the overall winner of the Leinster Amateur Tour the highest placed rider on the day of the final will be deemed the overall Leinster Amateur Tour winner, same applies to 2<sup>nd</sup> place, 3<sup>rd</sup> place, etc...
- There will be fantastic overall tour prizes for the top 6 horse/rider combinations of the tour and for placings 1 to 6 at the final. You have to be present at the final to be eligible for the prize – otherwise the prize moves down to the next person in line
- A horse/rider combination is only allowed accumulate points at one show on any one day
- Leader boards will be updated after each leg of the tour with results posted on [www.sjilive/](http://www.sjilive/) under **Rankings**. Updates will be given on the Leinster region SJI amateur page *#leinsterregionsji* and also on the Showjumping Ireland WhatsApp Channel.
